You can apply with an Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN) if you don't have a Social Security Number. Your information is safe and won't be shared.

Other benefits are not affected.

Tax credits don't count as income, and won't affect your eligibility for other benefits like TANF or SNAP.

People without kids are eligible.
