

The Working Families Tax Credit is a new cash rebate of up to \$1,200 for Washington individuals and families starting in February 2023.

Did you...

Live in Washington for more than six months in 2022?

File your taxes for 2022, or plan to?

Earn at least \$1 in income in 2022?

You could be eligible for this new tax credit of up to \$1,200.



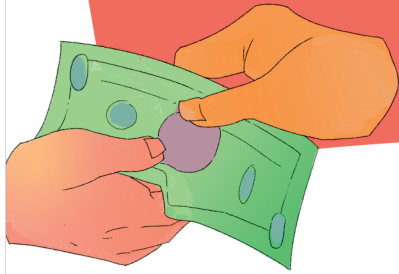

Don't miss out on your payment.



Community members advocated for this new tax credit to make sure people have the cash they need to put food on the table or pay for unexpected expenses.

This cash belongs to you.

Immigrants are eligible, regardless of status.

You can apply with and Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN) if you don't have a Social Security Number. Your information is safe and won't be shared.

Other benefits are not affected.

Tax credits don't count as income, and won't affect your eligibility for other benefits like TANF or SNAP.

People without kids are eligible.

Single filers can apply!
